We are achieving this with the help of some custom tabs on our facebook fan page. We have added custom tabs for Sponsor Links, Past Events, Newsletters, and Team Videos. All of this content resides on our [teamoceankayak.com](http://www.teamoceankayak.com) website and will drive traffic through facebook and onto our team website. We were able to build the beta site, gain 25 fans rather quickly, register [teamoceankayak](http://www.teamoceankayak.com) as a fan page with facebook, and build out our initial page design.

### Team Ocean Kayak in Xtreme Kayak Redfish Tournament Matagorda, TX

Team Ocean Kayak's Vincent Rinando, Captain Filip Spencer, Clint Barghi, Cameron Barghi, Sam Rinando, and Rick Spillman fielded three teams in the Xtreme Kayak series held in Matagorda, Texas. The team spent several weeks fishing the Matagorda area under harsh weather conditions that seemed to plague the Gulf Coast for most of the month of June. Unable to really find any quality fish, we opted to fish the eastern boundaries of the tournament a little closer to our home waters of Galveston. Clint and Cameron Barghi placed 4th, Sam and Rick placed 7th, and Vincent and Filip placed 8th. Unable to keep their fish alive, Vincent Rinando and Captain Filip Spencer's fish died and they were forced to take a 1lb deduction penalty. This penalty dropped them from 4th to 8th place.

Currently Sam and Rick are 3rd place for Team of the Year and Vincent Rinando and Captain Filip Spencer are currently in 4th place. There are two more tournaments in this series remaining, one in Freeport near Galveston and the other in Corpus Christi. We feel confident that we will be able to make up the weight we are lacking to overtake 1st place. We are expecting this series to come down to the final event, unless one of the front runners stumbles at the next event.

Seems like for the month of June we have been cursed with strong winds and hot temperatures. This tournament was no different. Winds in excess of 15 mph and temperatures reaching 100, made fishing and keeping the fish you caught alive.
